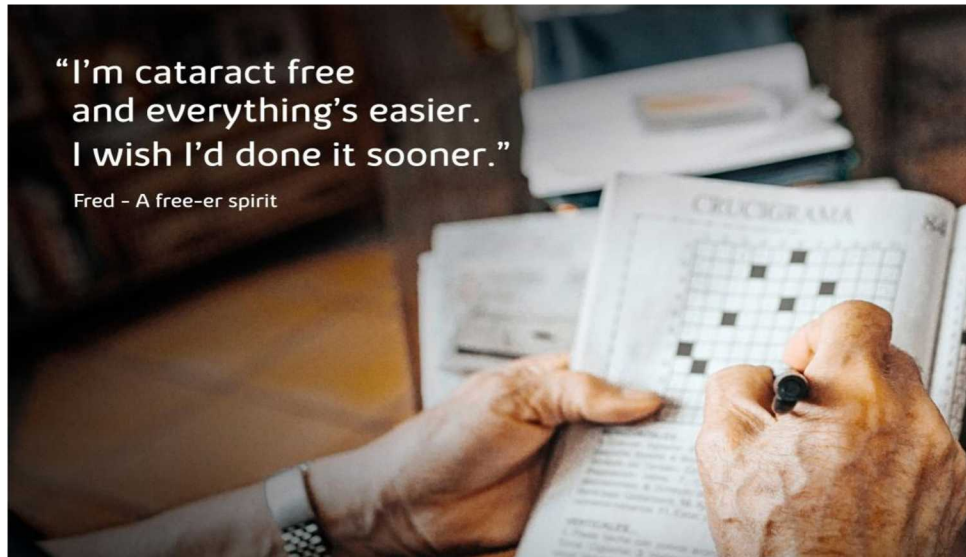


Fred's deteriorating eyesight made his life difficult, so a successful cataract operation has transformed his daily life – Read Fred's story below:



“I lost the sight in my right eye several years ago, so when the sight in my left eye started to deteriorate, I knew I had to do something about it.

I couldn’t get up and walk anywhere, as I couldn’t see very well. I had to hold on to things when trying to get about. It was just as well that I know my house so well, as it meant that I could feel my way round, but it did make going out very difficult.
