Mr Chris Little is Consultant Hand Surgeon at the Nuffield Orthopaedic Centre and in the Trauma Unit at the John Radcliffe Hospital, Oxford. He offers private treatment for hand and wrist problems at the Nuffield Manor Hospital in Headington, Oxford.

Trained in Bristol, Oxford and Birmingham, Mr Little is a fellowship-trained specialist in hand, wrist and elbow surgery. He has been based at the internationally renowned Nuffield Orthopaedic Centre in Oxford since 2006, and has a particular expertise in the treatment of hand and wrist injuries, carpal tunnel syndrome and Dupuytren's contracture using the latest arthroscopic (keyhole) and minimally invasive surgical techniques.

The scaphoid is a small bone located at the base of the thumb just above the radius bone of the wrist, in the area where the wrist bends. Injuries to the scaphoid are very common, often occurring when a hand is put out to break a fall. Symptoms that the scaphoid has been damaged include pain and swelling at the base of the thumb, although in some cases the pain is not severe and may be mistaken for a sprain. It should be noted, however, that simple sprains to the wrist are rare and that if the pain does not resolve quickly following an injury, a doctor's opinion should be sought.
