

Shashank Gurjar Consultant Colorectal & Laparoscopic Surgeon London

Mr Shashank Gurjar is a Consultant Colorectal Surgeon at the Luton & Dunstable Hospital in Bedfordshire. A member of GI Doctors, a multidisciplinary team of London gastrointestinal specialists, he provides expert treatment for lower GI condition including colorectal cancer, diverticular disease, inflammatory bowel disease, abdominal wall and groin hernia, haemorrhoids, fissures and fistula, and pelvic floor dysfunction.

Mr Gurjar qualified in medicine from St Mary's Hospital, London in 1997 and completed his basic surgical training on the King's College surgical rotation. He undertook research at the Royal Free Hospital and University College London, and completed his specialist training in colorectal surgery in the South East Thames region. He completed his training with a post-CCT (Certificate of Completion of Training) fellowship in pelvic floor surgery at John Radcliffe Hospital in Oxford.

Mr Gurjar was appointed as a Consultant Surgeon in 2011 and currently holds a post at the Luton & Dunstable Hospital where he provides a full range of general and advanced colorectal surgery procedures. As co-director of undergraduate education at Luton & Dunstable Hospital, he is responsible for training young surgeons in laparoscopic (keyhole) surgery, as well as teaching medical students attached to the hospital.

Mr Gurjar is a member of GI Doctors LLP, a team of leading London specialists in gastroenterology, upper GI surgery and lower GI surgery.
