



Ian McNab

Mr Ian McNab is an Oxford-based hand and wrist surgeon offering expert assessment and treatment for the full range of conditions affecting the hand and wrist, including injury, arthritis, tendon problems and nerve compression, with a specialist expertise in complex wrist problems.

Mr McNab trained at the London Hospital Medical College, University of London as an undergraduate and subsequently in orthopaedic surgery at St Bartholomew's Hospital. He completed his rotation in: Stanmore, Essex, Norwich, Great Ormond Street, and at the Royal London Hospital, obtaining the certificate of completion of specialist training in trauma and orthopaedic surgery in 1999. His specialist fellowship training was undertaken in hand and upper limb surgery in Oxford and then during a year spent in Melbourne, Australia.

Mr McNab was appointed as a specialist Consultant Hand Surgeon at the Nuffield Orthopaedic Centre and John Radcliffe Hospital in 2000. Emergency and trauma hand surgery is undertaken at the John Radcliffe Hospital, planned and reconstructive hand surgery is undertaken at the Nuffield Orthopaedic Centre.

His teaching and academic appointments are: Honorary Senior Clinical Lecturer in the Nuffield Department of Orthopaedic Surgery, and as an honorary lecturer in clinical medicine at Wadham College, University of Oxford.

Trained in London, Oxford and Melbourne, Australia, Mr McNab is a fellowship-trained specialist in hand and upper limb surgery. Appointed as a consultant hand surgeon at Oxford University Hospital NHS Trust in 2000, he provides elective and reconstructive surgery at the internationally renowned Nuffield Orthopaedic Centre and emergency and trauma surgery at the John Radcliffe Hospital.

In private practice Mr McNab offers non-operative and surgical management of hand and wrist injuries, tendon problems, nerve compression syndromes, arthritis, congenital hand abnormalities, hand swellings and Dupuytren's contracture. He has a special interest and expertise in complex wrist problems, including scaphoid fractures and scaphoid fracture non-union, and offers a number of advanced techniques such as vascularised bone grafting and microsurgical repair of nerves and vessels.
