Dr Alistair J Makin offers private diagnosis and management for a range of gastroenterological complaints including pancreatitis, pancreatic cancer, complex Crohn's and ulcerative colitis at Spire Manchester Hospital and BMI The Alexandra Hospital, Cheadle.

Alistair J Makin FRCP, MD, MBBS is a Consultant Gastroenterologist at Manchester Royal Infirmary and runs a private practice at the Spire Manchester Hospital and at The Alexandra Hospital, Cheadle. He currently takes referrals from all over the North and North West with pancreatic and biliary disease. Dr Makin has a wide experience of managing patients with pancreatitis, pancreatic cancer and diseases of the biliary tree.

Dr Makin qualified from Charing Cross and Westminster Medical School, London in 1988. He completed his junior training in London and Gloucester and was awarded Membership of the Royal College of Physicians in 1991. He returned to London to work at Harefield Hospital and then on the Liver Unit at King's College Hospital where he received extensive training in all aspects of liver disease including transplantation and acute liver failure. He was awarded a British Digestive Foundation Training Fellowship and completed his MD thesis on Alterations in Hepatic Blood Flow and Kupffer Cell Activation in the Pathogenesis of Toxic Hepatic Injury. This work has been published and presented at international meetings.

In 1996 he was appointed as Senior Registrar in Gastroenterology at Middlesex/UCH Hospital in London. During these 2 years he underwent intensive training in therapeutic endoscopy including ERCP, EUS and laser endoscopy and in both pancreato-biliary disease and inflammatory bowel disease.

He was later appointed as a consultant at Manchester Royal Infirmary where he currently takes referrals from the North West with complex pancreatic and biliary disease. Dr Makin has a particular interest in the endoscopic management of both benign and malignant pancreato-biliary cases and he is actively involved in the management of complex inflammatory bowel disease. He also has wide experience of immunosuppression and biological therapy with one of the largest treatment cohorts in the UK. Dr Makin is a faculty member at The Mersey School of Endoscopy where he regularly trains on colonoscopy and basic endoscopy courses.
