

# Shahab Siddiqi

Recognised as one of the UK's most experienced surgeons in the field of robotic-assisted surgery, Mr Shahab Siddiqi is an Essex-based Consultant Surgeon specialising in pelvic floor medicine and surgery, irritable bowel syndrome, whole gut motility disorders, functional bowel disorders and pruritus ani.

A member of GI Doctors, a multidisciplinary team of leading London specialists, Mr Siddigi offers a holistic approach to the treatment of colonic and anorectal disorders, blending cutting edge robotic and laparoscopic surgery with the medical management of functional bowel conditions and pelvic pain.

Mr Siddiqi graduated from St George's Hospital Medical School in London in 1993. He received an MD degree from the University of London in 2008 for his research on methods to improve detection of the spread of colorectal cancer to the lymph glands using genetic techniques, carried out at the Royal London Hospital.

Mr Siddiqi undertook his specialist training in general and colorectal surgery at the North Thames Deanery, and completed a pelvic floor fellowship at Castle Hill Hospital in Hull, a leading centre for the treatment of pelvic floor disorders. He then went on to take up a laparoscopic surgery fellowship at Waikato Hospital in Hamilton, New Zealand. During his time at this innovative unit specialising in keyhole surgery, he developed an interest in pelvic floor and minimal access surgery.

Mr Siddigi has been a Consultant Surgeon at Broomfield Hospital since 2011. As lead for pelvic floor and colorectal robotic surgery, he has led the development of the hospital's advanced robotic surgery facility, and is recognised as one of the country's most experienced surgeons in this field. With clinical interests that are both medical and surgical, he has introduced innovative treatments for faecal incontinence and constipation and offers a holistic approach to the treatment of pelvic, colonic and anorectal conditions.

Mr Siddiqi is Honorary Senior Lecturer at Anglia Ruskin University. He is also a tutor for the Care of the Critically III Surgical Patient and Basic Surgical Skills courses aimed at trainee surgeons, and for the Training and Assessment of the Clinical Environment course for consultant surgeons.
