Mr Charles Willis-Owen is an Oxford-trained orthopaedic surgeon specialising in knee surgery and sports injuries. Charles graduated in medicine from Oxford University in 2000. He undertook his specialist orthopaedic training on the prestigious North West Thames training rotation. In his spare time, he also qualified in Sports and Exercise and Sports Psychology, becoming triple-qualified in orthopaedic surgery, sports medicine and sports psychology.

During his specialist training, Charles was awarded a fellowship at Sportsmed SA, South Australia's leading sports clinic, which gave him the opportunity to learn from some of the world's best sports knee and hip surgeons.

Charles was appointed as a Consultant Orthopaedic Surgeon in 2011, working initially at the major trauma unit at St Mary's Hospital in Central London and then for four years in South East London. Having developed his skills and reputation in the capital, he relocated with his young family to Dorset.

Charles is passionate about all forms of sport. He has represented Great Britain in the cycling World Championships, competed at international elite level for marathon running and rowed at Oxford University amongst other achievements. This unique experience coupled with his unique training has provided him with a deep understanding of the challenges that athletes and active people of all abilities face and the frustration that injury can cause.

Charles has played an active role in clinical research and academia throughout his career. He has published over 40 papers and has presented at international scientific meetings. His current interest is in speeding up recovery by protecting and perfecting sleep.

Charles acts as an advisor to the orthopaedic industry and is currently developing his own surgical device. He has been advising on the development of new robotic surgery technology.
